Cycling: There are several MTB trails with different levels of difficulty and mountain elevations in the vicinity of Poráč Park.



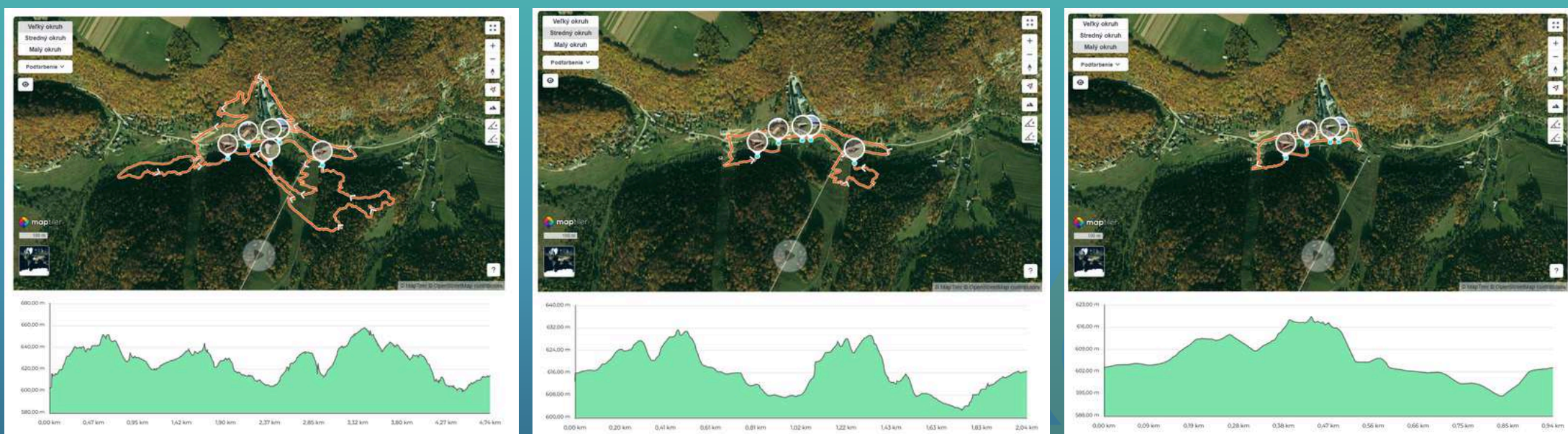

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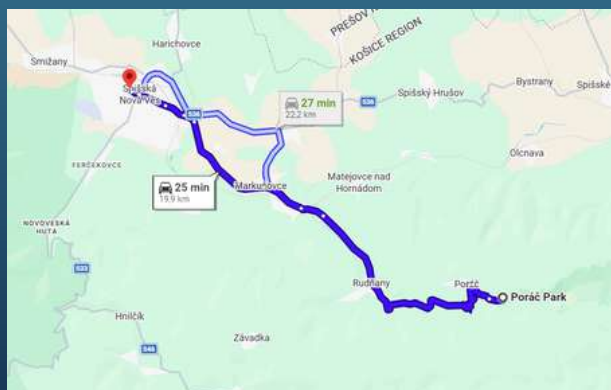
Hotel Metropol Wellness & Congress Hotel****

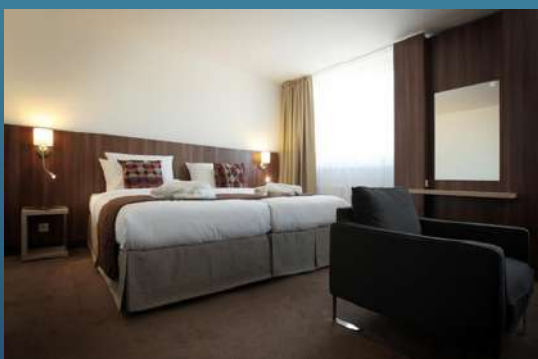

Open Training: Tracks will be accessible throughout the event at the rider's own risk (except during official races). No course security or medical services are provided outside official hours.

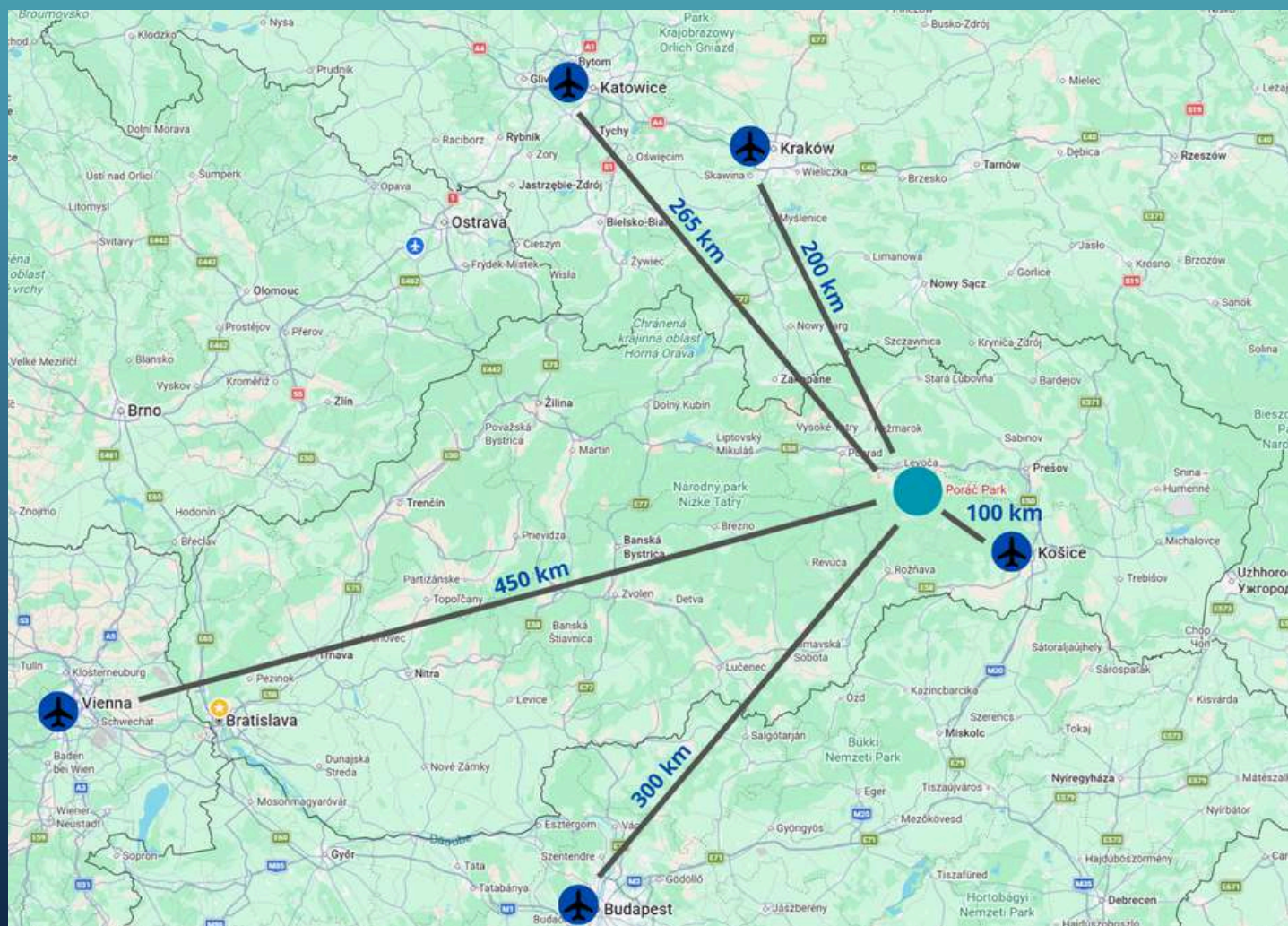

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SURROUNDINGS



Spiš Castle

World cultural heritage, inscribed on the UNESCO list. The dominant feature of eastern Slovakia, which exceeds 4 hectares in area, is located approximately 35 km from Poráč Park. It rises above the village of Spišské Podhradie.



Church of St. James in Levoča

The Levoča Cathedral is one of the largest Gothic churches in Slovakia. It is a national cultural monument, which includes a hand-carved altar by the medieval woodcarver Master Pavol of Levoča. It is the highest Gothic altar in the world, with a length of more than 18 meters.



Mining Museum

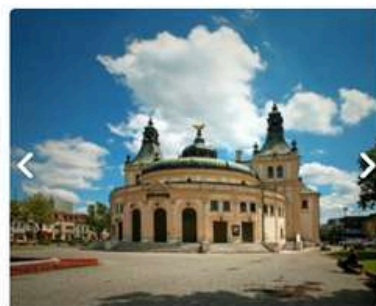
The Poráč Mining Trail and Mining Museum in the village of Poráč map **mining history** for future generations. Activists strive to preserve existing mining monuments and at the same time seek opportunities to promote mining traditions for local residents and visitors.

Markušovce

Markušovce is an old historical village located in the valley of the Hornád River five kilometers east of the town of Spišská Nová Ves. The richly decorated **Dardanel Summer Palace**, a historic building from 1777, is worth a visit. Also worth seeing is **Markušovský hrib** – an 8-meter-high rock formation, the specific shape of which was created by uneven weathering of rocks. It is one of the most famous in Slovakia.



Spišská Nová Ves

Spišská Nová Ves is located in the Hornád Basin, surrounded from the north by the Levoča Mountains and from the south by the Spiš-Gemer Ore Mountains. The town and its surroundings are very attractive and culturally and historically rich, with preserved folk architecture. The surroundings of Spišská Nová Ves also offer a number of cultural and natural sights.



Galmus

The **Galmus** plain and mountains are located in the northeast of the Volovské vrchy. The highest peak here is the **Skala** peak (1014 m above sea level). There are various karst formations such as depressions and sinkholes and caves. The most famous cave is the **Šarkanova diera** cave, 177 meters long. Its peculiarity is that various archaeological finds from the Neolithic period were found there.
